These extended hours are pre-bookable for those patients who have difficulty in attending during normal working hours.



# Thinkpharmacy SUPPORT ADVICE TREATMENT

Sometimes getting to the Doctor is tricky. You may be short of time or all the GP Appointments have been booked up.. It can be frustrating not being able to get expert help! But have you ever thought of 'popping in' to your local pharmacy? It's easier than you think!

Your Pharmacist can give you confidential, expert advice on all sorts of common health problems. You can talk to them in a private consultation room about your ailments, many of which are listed below. The Pharmacist can supply some medicines that would normally need a prescription and you won't have to see a Doctor first. If you currently get free prescriptions, you won't have to pay for your treatment. If you pay for your prescriptions, you will pay no more than the current prescription charge for each item
